Because of each and every member, our club is already Distinguished... YEAH!!!! That is a lot of hard work put on by each member of Simi Valley Toastmasters!



History of Our Club

Simi Valley Toastmasters Club #3533 is the oldest club in Simi Valley. It has been around since September 29, 1977. There were many members that have come and gone, but we will never forget them and forever will be grateful to everyone for all their help in keeping Simi Valley Toastmasters striving.

In the beginning the club met at the local high school in the science room, fish tank and all. After a few years the club nearly disbanded. At one time it was down to four members. But those four members persevered and rebuilt the membership. One of those members, Tom Reilly, is still with us today. Later, the club also met at a portable classroom at Lincoln Elementary School used for Day Care by the YMCA. Sometimes a pet rabbit escaped from his cage and would run in circles around the speaker. Then, the club met at the United Church of Christ on Royal Avenue. Next, we met at the Simi Valley Chamber of Commerce which helped the club gain exposure and become more of a part of the community. Currently, the club meets at the Sunrise Assisted Living Center in a very nice room for our meetings, and our membership has grown to over 30 members.
